By taxi:

A taxi from the airport should cost 60 or 70 euros.

By train:

From Barcelona: Take the train in the direction of "Vilanova- Sant Vicenç de Calders" or "Vilanova" at "Barcelona Sants" or "Paseo de Gracia" stations. Get off at the Sitges train station and get a taxi to the hotel.

From the airport: Take the train in the direction of "El Prat de Llobregat". Change trains there; take the train in the direction of "Vilanova". Get off at the Sitges train station.

By car:

From Barcelona: Exit at "Gran Via de les Corts Catalanes" take the direction "Tarragona" following the motorway C-32 signs, directions Sitges. After the tolls booths, take the exit number 26 to "Sant Pere de Ribes - Vilanova". On the first roundabout, drive in the direction of "Sitges - Vilanova"; at the second roundabout follow the Sitges signs. Turn to the right following the Dolce Sitges signs at the Masia Can Girona Road.
